



Advocacy for Children and Young People Stoke-on-Trent

You may be able to access advocacy for meetings, reviews or assessments. Anyone can make a referral.

Advocates can:

- ensure wishes and feelings are known when a decision is being made
- attend decision making meetings
- uphold rights and ensure fair treatment
- provide impartial information
- ask questions important to the young person
- support the young person to raise concerns or make complaints.

Eligibility criteria:

- aged between 5-18, or up to 25 if a care leaver under 'Staying Put' legislation
- a looked after child under the local authority
- subject to Child in Need or Child Protection
- children with disabilities and their siblings
- subject to special healthcare provision or have an EHCP
- undergoing a secure accommodation review
- age assessments for asylum seeking young people.
